

## The Spiritual War in Your Home, Part 8 | the statistics

### I. Our Experiences Teach Us that Most People Reject God.

- Most of the world rejects Biblical Truth.
- The majority of people who grew the church turn away from what they learned.

### II. The Bible Teaches Us that Most People Reject God.

- Matthew 7:13-14, Genesis 3-11; Psalm 2; Romans 1
- Adam and Eve didn't have a sin nature of the World System. But they fell to Satan's one temptation.
- After a little over 1,000 years, everyone but Noah and his family rebelled against God.
- After about 1,000 years after the flood, the Tower of Babel incident occurred.
- The Children of Israel repeatedly rebelled against God.
- Some of the disciples weren't born again until after the resurrection, all but one deserted Him during the crucifixion, and one of Jesus' disciples betrayed Him.

### III. The Final Spiritual Battle Teaches Us that Most People Reject God.

- Revelation 20:7-10
- The tribulation is over. Satan has been bound for 1,000 years in the pit, and Jesus Christ is on His earthly throne. Among His citizens are the redeemed saints who either died before the tribulation or who were raptured. They are glorified and completely incapable of sin. There are also unglorified believers who were saved during the tribulation and who didn't die during its atrocities.
- The vast majority of the citizenry (in the beginning) are free from the temptation to sin, the others are devoted followers of Christ, and Satan and His demons are not around to possess unbelievers or wreak physical havoc. There also is technically no World System. The only spiritual enemy left if the Fleshly Sin Nature still left in the unglorified saints.
- As the Millennial Reign of Christ continues, the unglorified believers are having children. These children are growing and having children. And the whole time these kids are living under the perfect, loving, and holy rule of the God Himself. They can see the beautiful relationships among His followers. They can see the promised future of believers as they watch and interact with glorified saints. And this goes on for 1,000 years.
- Every child born during this time has to make the same choice every other human has had to make. They need to personally choose to put their faith and trust in Jesus Christ as their Savior. They need to be born again and follow Him. But is that what happens?
- Even though hundreds of thousands of Christians will enter the Millennium, and even though none of them will die that entire time, and even though they will have plenty of kids, and those children will have kids for hundreds of years, and even though Jesus Christ Himself is on the throne of the world, and Satan and the World System are no longer operating . . . at the end of the Millennial reign, the vast majority of them will rebel against God.
- Satan will be released on these people, and He will go right back to his possessing and influencing. It won't be long until his propaganda machine is back in business and the World System is tempting people just like it always did. And those billions of people will rally around Satan for one last-ditch attempt to overthrow God. And there will be so many of them that they will surround the camp of the saints — that's the glorified saints from history past as well as the ones saved during the Tribulation.
- And how could that even happen? It happens because that's how mankind is.
